

10 highest performing schools in Leicestershire for GCSEs revealed - is your kid's school on the list?



Statistics based on GCSE grades have revealed the highest and lowest performing schools in [Leicestershire](#). Though 55 have failed to meet the government's minimum standards for GCSE grades, many have excelled.

This is shown by new figures based on the 'Progress 8' measure.

Before this, schools were deemed successful or not depending on the percentage of pupils who achieved five or more A* to C grades including English and maths.

Progress 8 means the results of every child at every grade in eight subjects will count, rather than just a few around the threshold of C or above.

A school's Progress 8 score is the average of all the pupils' scores across those subjects.

For this year, the baseline standard is 0.

If a school's Progress 8 score is greater than 0 it can be interpreted as meaning that it has achieved above-average progress compared to pupils nationally.

If a school scores below 0 it has performed worse than the national average.
