# KS3 Languages Homework – Guide for Parents

## What and how should my child complete their homework?

What? Students to learn words for a vocab test each week

How long for? 40 minutes per week

How to revise? Divide the time into 4 x 10 minute sessions per week minimum

What is the recap? Tests include words from previous tests

What resources? 1 paper copy of vocab sheet per unit + electronic resources on Show My Homework

#### How many words should my child be revising?

Route 23: 10 words passively or 5 words actively
Route 45: 10 words passively or 10 words actively
Route 89: 10-15 words passively or 15 words actively

We would appreciate your support in helping your child to revise effectively using the steps listed below. Please note, you do not need to know French yourself to help.

## <u>PASSIVE</u> - for **READING** and **LISTENING**, understanding from <u>FRENCH into ENGLISH</u>.

Using paper and pen and the vocab sheet:

- Read the words
- Cover up the English
- Write the English
- <u>Check</u> whether it is correct or not
- Repeat in order until they are all correct
- Create a test by putting the words in a random order
- Repeat until all are correct

\*\*Highlight the words that you don't know and practise those in the order above before revising all words together

Using Quizlet functions (link on SMH):

- Flashcards French into English
- Match
- <u>Learn</u> into English
- Write into English
- <u>Test</u> into English
- Gravity into English

\*Always answer in English. Click on options button to answer into English

\*\*Star the words that you don't know and practise those in the order above before revising all words together

## <u>ACTIVE</u> - for WRITING and SPEAKING, understanding from <u>ENGLISH</u> into <u>FRENCH</u>.

Using paper and pen and the vocab sheet:

- Follow the instructions for passive learning to make sure words are understood in English
- Read the words
- Cover up the French
- Write the French one by one
- Check whether it is correct or not
- Any words spelt incorrectly should be written out 3 times
- Create a test by putting the words in a random order

\*\*Highlight the words that you don't know and practise those in the order above before revising all words together

- Learn into French
- Write into French
- Test into French
- Gravity into French
