Scholarships & Bursaries

The Sir Thomas White Loan Charity (STWLC) awards scholarships to exceptionally academically high-achieving young people, who wish to attend an independent school in Leicester, <u>Leicestershire</u> or Rutland for their sixth form (Years 12 and 13) education.

Up to three scholarships are available each year and STWLC covers the cost of tuition fees for the two years of A-level study (or provides money towards the tuition in partnership with the awarding school by arrangement with the school).

In previous years The Sir Thomas White Loan Charity has awarded scholarships to young people at <u>Leicester High</u> <u>School</u>, <u>Leicester Grammar School</u> and <u>Ratcliffe College</u>.

Young people who wish to apply for the scholarship should:

- Live permanently in Leicester, Leicestershire or <u>Rutland;</u>
- Currently be attending a state school in Leicester, Leicestershire or <u>Rutland;</u>
- Expect to gain at least 9 GCSEs graded from 7 9. References will be taken from the current school to confirm this;
- Their household should have a maximum of £50,000 income pa. (This will be means tested by the schools applied to);
- Have the drive and ambition to achieve exceptional results at A-level and go on to study at a top university.
