Responsible for the information that goes on a company's website and/or other digital channels.

MARKETING MANAGER

Plan how to promote products, services or brands and oversee all marketing activity.

COPY EDITOR

Check text before it's published in books, journals, and websites.

PROOFREADER

Check text before it's printed or published to make sure it's correct and complete.

• PUBLISHER

Responsible for the overall quality of a publication, whether that be a book, newspaper, journal, magazine or website.
